With M-Files Reporting, you can produce business intelligence analyses by designing reports and dashboards that take data from the M-Files repository as well as from your other IT systems - such as your ERP, CRM, or accounting and billing systems. Process-related performance information can be easily combined with process outcomes recorded in your business systems. For example, you can analyze outstanding proposals issued by your sales staff combined with their sales revenue figures recorded in your CRM system in order to glean greater insight into the effectiveness of your sales team's activities and processes.
