

## SQL Server Licensing with M-Files

## Question

What type of SQL Server licensing is required for M-Files backend use? I am not referring to the editions, but to the actual licensing options, e.g.: Server+CAL vs. Core-based. E.g. if one opts for the Server+CAL method, how many CALs are required?

## **Answer**

Microsoft SQL Server EULA says that every user that uses the data hosted in SQL Server needs a license.

You can fulfill this requirement in two different ways:

- 1. By purchasing Server Licenses + a Client Access License (CAL) for every M-Files user, OR
- 2. By purchasing "Per Core Licenses".

You can use the following spreadsheet to estimate license cost and to choose the optimal license plan (SQL Server 2012) of different editions: Microsoft SQL Server pricing.xlsx.

Note: when using concurrent M-Files user licenses, the required number of SQL Server Client Access Licenses is based on the number of login accounts, not the number of concurrent user licenses.
