

Supported File Formats in Annotation

You can annotate and redline files without modifying the actual file content. This feature supports most common file types, including the following:

- Microsoft Word files (docx, docm, dotx, dotm, doc, dot, rtf)
- HTML and web archive files (htm, html, mht, html)
- Microsoft Excel files (xlsx, xlsm, xlsx, xltm, xlsb, xlt)
- Microsoft PowerPoint files (pptx, pptm, ppsx, ppsm, potx, potm, ppt, ppps, pot)
- OpenDocument files (odt, ott, ods, odp)
- Visio Drawings (vsd, vdx, vss, vsx, vst, vtx, vdw)
- Email files (eml, eml, msg)
- PDF's

Annotation of image files

While annotation features are not supported for certain image file formats like tiff, jpg, or gif, you can use M-Files OCR add-on to convert these files to searchable PDF's and then annotate the PDF files.
